OUT OF UNIFORM AND T-SHIRT DAY GUIDELINES

Fort Worth Academy will have occasional out-of-uniform and t-shirt days, explained as follows:

Authorized T-shirt Days:

- Participation is optional.
- One Friday of every month will be a T-Shirt of the Year day. The T-Shirt of the Year is the out-of-uniform shirt option for those days.
- The purchase of a year-long Friday T-Shirt Pass includes a T-Shirt of the Year to wear on one Friday a month and allows students to wear a Fort Worth Academy Spirit Shirt on all other Fridays.
- T-shirts do not need to be tucked in.
- Denim jeans and shorts or uniform bottoms may be worn. (Shorts are usually about 2" or less above the knee in length.) Short-shorts are not allowed.
- Distressed jeans allowed at discretion of faculty.
- Uniform shoe regulations apply.
- Outerwear must meet Academy uniform requirements.
- Students choosing not to wear the T-shirt must wear the regular uniform.

Out-of-Uniform Days:

- These days are held in addition to T-Shirt Days and will be announced.
- Participation is optional.
- Shirts displaying profanity, tobacco or alcohol messages, or any other undesirable logo, image or text, will not be permitted.
- Spaghetti straps, cropped tops, or off the shoulder tops are not allowed.
- Athletic shoes must be worn in P.E.

Other:

- On Halloween, no masks, weapons or blow-up costumes are permitted.
- On Western Day, no guns or spurs are permitted.
- T-shirts must not be too tight or altered in any way.
