



Helpful Information

- Camps run for **one week at a time** with new themes and offerings each week!
- Register your child based on the **grade your child will enter in the 26-27** academic year.
- **Half-Day camps** run from **9:00am to 12:00pm**. **Full Day Camps** run from 9:00am to 3:00pm, with a built-in lunch time. Full-day campers will need to bring a packed lunch.
- Please note that Fort Worth Academy and all coinciding camps will be **closed on Friday, June 19th** in observance of the Juneteenth holiday.
- **Registration Timeline:**
 - **Wednesday, February 18:** Registration opens!
 - **Friday, April 10:** Registration reviewed to ensure minimum enrollment is met.
 - **Friday, May 15:** Registration closes for Weeks 1-4. After this date, no refunds will be issued and camp registration is considered final.
 - Friday, June 12, Registration closes for Weeks 5-10. After this date, no refunds will be issued and camp registration is considered final.
 - **Students may register for any camps that made up to the Wednesday before the scheduled start date.**
- **Age Requirements:** Camp participants must be **at least 4 years old** by the start of the summer season (June 1, 2026).
- **FWA Exclusive Camps: Open Gym** and **Best Camp Ever** are reserved for students currently enrolled at Fort Worth Academy. Best Camp Ever is open to all rising 1st to 5th Grade students and will begin Week 4 and run through the end of the summer. Open Gym is available to 5th-8th grade students and will be on the following dates: June 2, 4, 9, 11, July 7, 9, 21,23, and August 3, 6.
- **Before Care** is available for **rising 1st-5th Grade students** who are **enrolled in Best Camp Ever** beginning **Week 4 (June 22)** from 7:45am to 9:00am for families needing early drop-off. The fee for this service is \$50 per week.






Middle School: 5th – 8th Grade

Animation Studio: Lights, Camera, LEGO® Action: 9:00a-12:00p: \$228

In Animation Studio, middle school students become filmmakers as they dive into the creative world of stop-motion animation. Working in small teams, campers bring their stories to life using LEGO® mini-figures, custom-built sets, and hands-on animation tools. From brainstorming storylines and designing scenes to filming frame-by-frame motion and adding visual and audio effects, students experience the full animation process from start to finish. This engaging, collaborative program blends creativity and technology, encouraging teamwork, storytelling, and problem-solving while giving campers a final film they'll be excited to share long after camp ends.

Real World Robotics: 12:30p-3:30p: \$228

Build and Program Robots Inspired by Real Technology! In Snapology's Real World Robotics, students explore science and engineering by building robotic models inspired by machines like alarm systems, robotic arms, and earthquake detectors. Using gears, motors, sensors, and beginner-friendly drag-and-drop programming, kids develop critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving as they learn how simple machines work and control motors and sensors through visual coding. They also build, test, and improve their robots using the engineering design process while strengthening communication and teamwork.




